RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, the provision of adequate and modern housing to the members of the White Mountain Apache Tribe is a priority of the Tribal Council; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council has established an Indian Housing Authority whose responsibility is to develop and manage housing projects for the benefit of the White Mountain Apache Tribe; and
- WHEREAS, it is anticipated that current H.U.D. housing construction trends on the reservation will continue into the near future; and
- whereas, the various federal and tribal agencies on the reservation are of necessity required to play key roles in the development and construction of housing projects on the reservation and coordination of agency efforts is vital and fundamental to the success of each of the ongoing and future housing developments; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council is of the opinion that the various agencies responsible for carrying out the complete construction of housing projects should work hand in hand in an effort to bring about a speedy and efficient completion of the projects in the interest of providing homes for tribal members.
- THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the White Mountain Apache Indian Housing Authority, the B.I.A., the I.H.S., the Arizona Department of Transportation, and the Tribal Safety Department are hereby directed to coordinate their efforts in bringing about final construction of current and future housing projects on the Fort Apache Indian Reservation and to maintain this coordination through regular meetings, correspondence, and whatever means are deemed necessary to accomplish the task.

The foregoing resolution was on December 24, 1987, duly adopted by a vote of $\underline{\text{NINE}}$ for and $\underline{\text{ZERO}}$ against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (a) of the Amended Constitution and

Bylaws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
