## RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, the position of Criminal Justice Commissioner has been vacant for a considerable length of time and there is an urgent need to fill this position in the Tribal Administration; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council has received numerous complaints regarding the administration of justice on the Fort Apache Indian Reservation and the Tribal Council feels that part of the problem can be addressed by immediately appointing a Criminal Justice Commissioner to fill the vacant position; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council has the authority to appoint heads of departments and Mr. Vincent Craig possesses the qualifications necessary to carry out the responsibilities of the Criminal Justice Commissioner; and
- WHEREAS, Mr. Craig has expressed to the Chairman his willingness to assume those responsibilities;
- THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that Mr. Vincent Craig is hereby appointed Criminal Justice Commissioner contingent upon his acceptance of the position and the successful negotiation of the salary.

The foregoing resolution was on January 7, 1988, duly adopted by a vote of EIGHT for and ZERO against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (a), (i) & (s) of the Amended Constitution and Bylaws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
