RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council has been advised by the Council members for the Cibecue community that there is a need to purchase a tractor and a trailer for the benefit of the tribal members living in the Cibecue community; and
- WHEREAS, the tractor would be utilized to cultivate and prepare farm sites and gardens for the benefit of tribal members; and
- WHEREAS, funds are available in the Revenue Sharing Account for the purchase of a tractor and trailer; and
- WHEREAS, this is a valid governmental use of Revenue Sharing funds and the Tribal Council is of the opinion that the funds should be expended for this purpose.
- BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that funds are hereby appropriated from the Tribe's Revenue Sharing Account for the purchase of a tractor and trailer to be utilized for the benefit of tribal members living in the Cibecue community, and otherwise as the Tribal Council directs.

The foregoing resolution was on January 7, 1988, duly adopted by a vote of <u>SEVEN</u> for and <u>ZERO</u> against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1(a),(j),(i) of the Amended Constitution and Bylaws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
