RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, Vice Chairman Alvino Hawkins, Sr., has requested that the Tribal Council authorize payment to him for 80 hours of accrued annual leave due to extraordinary personal circumstances and due to his heavy workload and responsibilities as Vice Chairman he has been unable to take time off; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council deems it in the best interests of the Tribe to have the Vice Chairman continue to carry out his responsibilities on behalf of the Apache people at all times and places and to be available on a continuous basis, often without the opportunity to take time off;
- THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it authorizes the payment to Vice Chairman Alvino Hawkins, Sr., for 80 hours of accrued annual leave and directs the business office to process the payment.

The foregoing resolution was on January 7, 1988, duly adopted by a vote of <u>EIGHT</u> for and <u>ZERO</u> against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (a) & (i) of the Amended Constitution and Bylaws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
