BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby reaffirms Tribal Council Resolutions 11-87-308 through 12-87-357 in their entirety and without change.

The foregoing resolution was on January 7, 1988, duly adopted by a vote of NINE for and ZERO against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article VI, Section 1 (a) of the Amended Constitution and Bylaws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
