

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, a top priority of the Johnson-Hawkins Administration is to promote and provide career development, training, and employment opportunities for tribal members within the tribal enterprises, departments, and programs; and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council appointed Mr. Gilbert Cosen as Acting General Manager of the Agriculture Enterprise for the time period September 17, 1987 - December 31, 1987 at his current pay scale as Farm Supervisor; and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council is of the opinion that Mr. Cosen performed his responsibilities in a satisfactory manner as Acting General Manager; and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council has determined that based upon his satisfactory job performance as Acting General Manager, Mr. Cosen is entitled to receive back pay at the General Manager's pay scale of \$1,000.00 per pay period for the time period of September 17, 1987 - December 31, 1987;

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council that Mr. Cosen is to receive back pay in the amount of \$4,108.72 which represents an adjustment in pay scale from Farm Supervisor to General Manager for the time frame September 17, 1987 to December 31, 1987.

The foregoing resolution was on February 10, 1988, duly adopted by a vote of ELEVEN for and ZERO against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and Bylaws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
