RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, Councilmember Phil Stago is the General Manager of the White Mountain Apache Game and Fish Department and has presented to the Council a proposal to contract pursuant to Public Law 93-638 with the Bureau of Indian Affairs for management of the Tribe's wildlife and parks; and
- WHEREAS, Councilmember Stago, in his capacity as General Manager, has prepared an application to contract for assumption of the wildlife and parks program function, which includes inventorying, conserving, developing and managing the Tribe's wildlife resources and its related unique natural resources of the Tribe, and in conserving fish and wildlife resources on the Fort Apache Indian Reservation; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribe has adopted a Game and Fish Code which contains the essential conservation tools needed to manage and conserve the reservation's fish and wild-life resources; and
- WHEREAS, the White Mountain Apache Game and Fish Department has, during the last two decades, played a vital role in promoting the sound management of fish and wildlife resources on the Fort Apache Indian Reservation and has exhibited and continues to exhibit professional and managerial capabilities of the highest caliber.
- BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby gives it approval for the submission of the proposed wildlife and parks contract which will, if approved, enable the Tribal Game and Fish Department to continue its efforts to preserve the fish and wildlife and natural resources of the Fort Apache Indian Reservation.
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Tribal Chairman is authorized to execute the contract and any auxiliary and ancillary documents necessary to its fulfillment.

The foregoing resolution was on February 23, 1988, duly adopted by a vote of EIGHT for and ZERO against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article VI, Section 1(b),(i), of the Amended Constitution

and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior of May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
