RESOLUTION OF THE  
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE  
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, Raymus Albert, Chairman of the White Mountain Apache Land Board has come before the Tribal Council and has reviewed the minutes of the land board meetings for November 13, 1987, December 16, 1987, January 8, 1988 and February 12, 1988, and the Tribal Council is of the opinion that the Land Board minutes are complete in all necessary respects and should therefore be approved, including all valid actions taken by the Land Board at these meetings.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby approves the Land Board meeting minutes, including all valid actions taken in those minutes in assigning land to eligible tribal members during the months of November, December 1987, January, February 1988.

The foregoing resolution was on February 18, 1988, duly adopted by a vote of ten for and zero against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (h), (m) of the Amended Constitution and Bylaws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).

LAND BOARD MEETING MINUTES

February 12, 1988

A regularly scheduled Land Board Meeting was held on February 12, 1988 in the Council Chambers. Members present were Slim Quay, Lula A. Ivins, Esther T. Lupe and Edward Walker. The meeting was opened at 9:15 a.m.

Modesto Dunlap, Sr. requested the assignment of farmland No. 17, Power Canal which was assigned to his late father Wallace, recently his Uncle Stanley Dunlap said the farmland was his and wants to relinquish this land to the Dahkoshay family. Needs relinquishment from Stanley.

Mike Masciello's homesite application was approved, this application was checked out with other relatives, like Armstrong Billy and Jim Hopper and both said it was alright for him to have that land for a homesite.

Rosalind Kasey's homesite application at West Canyon Day Subdivision West side of Lamarr Malone was approved.

Mary L. Kasey's homesite application at Yucca Flat subdivision, Northeast of Eldred Alsenay trailer house was approved.

Eva M. Watt's homesite application at Whiteriver, North 5th Street and South of water tank, below Sonja Rogers was approved.

Bobby N. Johnson's homesite application was denied by the Board, he needs Livestock approval on this assignment.

Charlotte Bahlen' homesite application West of Donald Bahlen resident at North Fork, the lot she is requesting is already taken, she is to select another site.

Delphine K. Nozie needs to select another site, area requested is in Clarence Goklish's farmland or get his approval on this site.

Emerson Tate needs to select another site due to no water in the area and lot have to be one mile from reservation boundary.

Mr. Don Meclean from Roads Department said as long as there are 2 or more houses they will build the road to property line and needs 60 feet right of way for cut and fill on the slopes.

The North Fork Livestock Board Members, Paul Ethelbah and Vernall Gatewood said people from North Fork requests to have two areas set aside for the families, one is at Roundtop turn-off, West side for the Skidmore family and the other is Roundtop turn-off to Brewer's fence for North Fork people.

P.H.S. request for sewer pond at Roundtop turn-off on North of wash to serve that subdivision was approved by the Land Board, and said each community has enough water for more houses. Cedar Creek community should serve with sewerline and pond.

W.M.A.H.A. have until April 1, 1988 to submit application for 400 more houses to H.U.D. They have some site for subdivision and Land Office have some areas also, in each communities, so the plan is that Land Office draft up maps of location in each community and have each department, Land Office, WMAHA OFFICE, PHS Office on sewer and water and Roads Department to comment on each location at a later date, like during the week of February 22-26, 1988, and to present it to H.U.D. This plan was agreed on with PHS, WMAHA and Land Office. The meeting was adjourned at 11:20 a.m.
