RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, a primary objective of the Johnson-Hawkins Administration is to improve the financial position of the White Mountain Apache Tribe; and
- WHEREAS, significant cash flow improvements have been accomplished as documented by the fiscal year 1987 Touche & Ross Audit Report; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council has determined that the Director of Business Operations, Mr. Milfred Cosen has been instrumental in achieving these improvements;
- BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council that the Director of Business Operations, Mr. Milfred Cosen should receive reinstatement of a salary of \$45,000 per annum and back pay in the amount of \$4,897.50 retroactive to May 1, 1987 through February 19, 1988.

The foregoing resolution was on February 19, 1988, duly adopted by a vote of eight for and zero against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (a), (i) of the Amended Constitution and Bylaws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
