RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, Councilman Kino Kane has advised the Tribal Council that the Community of Carrizo desires to utilize the tin shack, which is owned by the Tribe and is located adjacent to the old Carrizo Trading Post, as a storage shed; and
- WHEREAS, Mr. Kane explained to the Council that the Community intends to relocate the building near the Carrizo Community Building; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council concurs with this request.
- BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby authorizes the Carrizo Community to utilize the tin shack located adjacent to the old Carrizo Trading Post; which tin shack will be relocated near the Carrizo Community Building

The foregoing resolution was on February 23, 1988, duly adopted by a vote of <u>EIGHT</u> for and <u>ZERO</u> against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article VI, Section 1(a) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior of May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
