

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, Mr. Anthony James, Tribal Purchasing Agent and Director of the Tribe's Purchasing Department has advised the Tribal Council that there is a need to purchase a new vehicle for the Purchasing Department; said vehicle being necessary in carrying out the work of the Purchasing Department; and

WHEREAS, bids have been requested and obtained from three sources and the low bid has been submitted by Heritage Chevrolet of Show Low for a 1988 Chevrolet Long-Bed Pickup Truck in the amount of \$9,608.05; and

WHEREAS, Mr. James has advised the Tribal Council that the Purchasing Department has expended only \$91,080 of its total 1987-88 budget of \$152,000 and Mr. James is of the opinion that the purchase of the vehicle of the new vehicle can be made from this year's existing budget without creating a deficit; and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council supports Mr. James' conclusion that a new vehicle is necessary for the Purchasing Department and is of the opinion that adequate funding is available in the current budget for the department in order to purchase this necessary capital equipment.

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby authorizes the expenditure of necessary funding not to exceed \$10,000 from Mr. James' 1987-88 budget for the purchase of a new 1988 Chevrolet 1/2 ton pickup truck from Heritage Motors of Show Low.

The foregoing resolution was on February 23, 1988, duly adopted by a vote of EIGHT for and ZERO against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1(i) of the Amended Constitution and Bylaws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
