

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, individual tribal member, Wren Cheney, has requested that the Tribal Council approve the leveling of his farmland of 28 acres, and that the driveway be graveled through the Farm Coop.; and


WHEREAS, the Farm Coop. manager, Justin Williams, has indicated he can assist Mr. Cheney in this manner; and

WHEREAS, it is in the best interest of the White Mountain Apache Tribe to encourage its tribal members to farm and thus utilize the Tribe's water resource through irrigation.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that approval is given to Justin Williams of the Farm Coop. to make the necessary arrangements to have the 28 acres assigned to Wren Cheney properly leveled so he can farm the area, and further that the driveway be graveled.

The foregoing resolution was on March 10, 1988, duly adopted by a vote of TEN for and ZERO against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1(a),(i) of the Amended Constitution and Bylaws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
