

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council by previous Council Resolution No. 12-87-342, acted to amend Tribal Ordinance No. 157 (the Tribal Election Code, Chapter 3 of the Government Code of the White Mountain Apache Tribe) to provide for an orderly election process during the 1988 Tribal Election; and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council Secretary was directed by that resolution to post said amendments for a minimum of ten days in accordance with the requirements of the Tribal Constitution, and the Council's directive to post the amendment for the minimum 10-day period has been to the amendments complied with, and there were no public comments or objections; and


WHEREAS, the Tribal Council has determined to grants its final approval to the amendment of Tribal Ordinance No. 157.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby enacts into law the provisions of Tribal Ordinance No. 157 as amended.

The foregoing resolution was on March 22, 1988, duly adopted by a vote of TEN for and ZERO against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article VIII, Section 8 (a) of the Amended Constitution and Bylaws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
