RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, Councilman Kino Kane has come before the Tribal Council on behalf of the Seven Mile Miracle Church, of which he is a member, for permission to utilize the Seven Mile Community playground to conduct the church's 6th Annual Youth Rally; and
- WHEREAS, said Youth Rally is scheduled for April 27, 28, 29 & 30, 1988, and it is anticipated that many churches and guest speakers, both local and state-wide, will be invited and will be in attendance; and
- WHEREAS, the occasion requires the use of a large tent in which to conduct said Youth Rally and the Seven Mile Community playground, which is located across from the Seven Mile Community Building, is a sufficient location for this event; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council concurs with this request.
- BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby approves the request of the Seven Mile Miracle Church to utilize the Seven Mile Community playground to erect a tent and conduct their 6th Annual Youth Rally on April 27, 28, 29 & 30, 1988.

The foregoing resolution was on April 14, 1988, duly adopted by a vote of TEN for and ZERO against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1(i) of the Amended Constitution and Bylaws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
