RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, Elaine Narcisco has come before the Tribal Council and brought to the Council's attention some discrepancies in the land assignment to Delores Burnette; and
- WHEREAS, the White Mountain Apache Tribal Council believes it is in the best interest of the White Mountain Apache Tribe and all parties involved to review this matter.
- THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the White Mountain Apache Tribal Council hereby rescinds that portion of Resolution 08-87-256 related to a land assignment to Delores Burnette.
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that Raymus Albert is directed to meet with all parties concerned and to make further recommendations regarding this matter to the Tribal Council after his review.

The foregoing resolution was on April 27, 1988, duly adopted by a vote of TEN for and ZERO against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1(i) of the Amended Constitution and Bylaws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
