RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe WHEREAS, has previously determined that land claims monies would be available to the various communities for their own particular projects; and
- the Canyon Day Community through its Tribal Council WHEREAS, representative Herbert Tate has requested that \$11,517 be released for use from the land claims monies.
- BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby authorizes the Canyon Day Community to establish a budget for \$11,517 to be used for community projects.
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that upon the establishment of a budget, the money may be released for said projects.
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that said budget be provided to the Tribal Treasurer of the White Mountain Apache Tribe and the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe for their information.

The foregoing resolution was on April 29, 1988, duly adopted by a vote of <u>SEVEN</u> for and <u>ONE</u> against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1(i) of the Amended Constitution and Bylaws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
