## RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, the term of Chief Judge Marvin Ethelbah has recently expired and the terms of Associate Judges Garland and Lewis will expire in July, 1988 and the Tribal Council is faced with a necessity of either reappointing these judges to their positions or selecting new personnel for these important positions; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council is of the opinion that Chief Judge Ethelbah and Associate Judge Garland and Lewis possess the requisite skills and knowledge necessary to fulfill the function of judges of the tribal court systems; and
- WHEREAS, pursuant to the Tribal Judicial Code the Tribal Council may nominate eligible tribal members to serve as judges of the tribal court.
- THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby nominates Chief Judge Marvin Ethelbah and Associate Judges Garland and Lewis to the positions they now hold in the tribal judicial system.

The foregoing resolution was on May 12, 1988, duly adopted by a vote of NINE for and ZERO against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and Bylaws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
