RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council has delegated to the Tribal Health Authority of the White Mountain Apache Tribe the direct administrative responsibility and authority over Tribal Health Programs including Patient Transportation; and
- WHEREAS, there is a need to continue transportation services to patients who lack adequate or dependable transportation; and
- WHEREAS, certain patients, including the handicapped and the elderly reside in isolated areas and great distances from the Whiteriver Hospital and the Cibecue Health Center; and
- WHEREAS, the Health Authority Director is applying for an Arizona Department of Transportation Grant for two (2) vans to be utilized for Patient Transportation Services; and
- WHEREAS, the equipment purchase price for the two (2) vans is estimated at \$43,000.00 eighty percent (80%) of which will be covered by the Arizona Department of Transportation Grant, leaving twenty percent (20%) of the equipment cost to be covered by the White Mountain Apache Tribe in the event of grant approval.
- WHEREAS, the Salary of the van drivers and the programs operational costs will be covered through September 30, 1988, by an Indian Health Service Contract.
- THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Tribal Council hereby authorizes the Health Authority Director to submit a proposal to the Arizona Department of Transportation for Capital Assistance to purchase two vans.
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Tribal Health Authority is authorized and directed to develop the necessary documents for the Tribal Chairman's signature and any other documents necessary to consumate the grant, and the Chairman or his designee shall have the authority to execute any and all documents and agreements necessary to fulfill the interest of this resolution.

The foregoing resolution was on April 11, 1988, duly adopted by a vote of <u>TEN</u> for and <u>ZERO</u> against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and Bylaws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
