RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, the Scotty Tenijieth, Cassandra Quintero, and Edith Starr, White Mountain Apache Tribal members, have brought to the White Mountain Apache Tribal Council their concern that a water well servicing Rainbow City housing area is in their use area and is interfering with their use; and
- WHEREAS, the White Mountain Apache Tribal Council wishes to grant their request that someone assist them with this problem; and
- WHEREAS, the White Mountain Apache Tribal Council does not wish to interfere with water availability to the Rainbow City housing area.
- THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the three Tribal Council members from District IV, Nelson Ethelbah, Ray J. Ivans, and Herbert Tate, are hereby directed to meet with Chris Kinney of the Indian Health Service and explore the possibility of moving the well to another location.

The foregoing resolution was on April 13, 1988, duly adopted by a vote of TEN for and ZERO against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1(i) of the Amended Constitution and Bylaws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
