## RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, Esther Crocker, a White Mountain Apache Tribal Member, has brought to the attention of the White Mountain Apache Tribal Council a situation where she has paid \$170.00 to Phil Smith from Cedar Creek to assist her in certain legal matters; and
- WHEREAS, the allegation is made that Phil Smith accepted the money but to date has provided no services for the same; and
- WHEREAS, Ms. Crocker requests assistance in the return of the \$170.00.
- THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the White Mountain Apache Tribal Council directs Scott Canty of the White Mountain Apache Tribal Legal Department to look into the matter and assist Mr. Crocker in whatever manner is appropriate.

The foregoing resolution was on April 13, 1988, duly adopted by a vote of <u>SEVEN</u> for and <u>ZERO</u> against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1(i) of the Amended Constitution and Bylaws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
