

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION


WHEREAS, Baxter and Queenie Quesada, parents of Heidi Quesada, have requested approval of the Tribal Council for them to sponsor an Apache Ceremonial Sunrise Dance for their daughter during the weekend of August 12, 13, 14, 1988; and

WHEREAS, Arvin and Ronita (Fall) Hostosevet have already been chosen and they have officially accepted their role of Godparents; and

WHEREAS, arrangements are already underway for the necessary ceremonial activities to be held in Whiteriver at the old tribal fairgrounds.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby grants the request of Baxter and Queenie Quesada, sponsors, and Arvin and Ronita (Fall) Hostosevet, Godparents, to hold an Apache Ceremonial Sunrise Dance for Heidi Quesada during the weekend of August 12, 13, 14, 1988 in Whiteriver at the old tribal fairgrounds.

The foregoing resolution was on April 14, 1988, duly adopted by a vote of SIX for and ZERO against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (g) & (i) of the Amended Constitution and Bylaws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
