RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, it has come to the attention of the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that Ms. June Quintero, a tribal member, was injured in 1986 while an employee of the Sunrise Ski Resort; and
- WHEREAS, Ms. Quintero's injuries are severe and permanent, depriving her of the ability to earn an adequate living, and necessitating numerous trips each month to various medical facilities for medical evaluation and treatment; and
- WHEREAS, the White Mountain Apache Tribal Council is advised that the Workmen's Compensation benefits being paid to Ms. Quintero are based on 66 2/3% of the difference between her average monthly wage before the injury and the wage that she is now able to earn and which monthly income is totally inadequate to meet her needs; and
- WHEREAS, the White Mountain Apache Tribe pursuant to its sovereign authority and its moral obligation to care for its members wishes to assist Ms. Quintero above and beyond the Workmen's Compensation award.
- THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe awards Ms. June Quintero, in full compensation of her injuries, \$10,000 in a lump sum payment to be paid out of the Sunrise Ski Resort Enterprise Budget.
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Tribal Council agrees to purchase a suitable vehicle for Ms. Quintero so that transportation is available to her to get the medical attention she needs.
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Tribal Council directs the Legal Department and the Tribal Chairman to arrange for the implementation of this award and further that they look into the possibility of rehabilitation services for Ms. Quintero.

The foregoing resolution was on April 14, 1988, duly adopted by a vote of NINE for and ZERO against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1(i) of the Amended Constitution and Bylaws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
