

RESOLUTION OF THE  
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE  
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, P.L. 94-142, Special Education Funding, provides programs for exceptional children in both BIA and public schools on the Fort Apache Indian Reservation; and


WHEREAS, the White Mountain Apache Tribe is very concerned about these important programs; and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe believes it is in the best interest of the White Mountain Apache Tribe to monitor these programs because of the potential benefit to our children that the programs offer and the desire of the Tribal Council to maximize that benefit.

BE IT RESOLVED that Council Member Lafe Altaha is appointed to monitor the programs for exceptional children provided by P.L. 94-142 in all schools on the Fort Apache Indian Reservation, and to monitor the availability and quality of educational facilities on the reservation, and is further directed to monitor adult education programs as provided by the Tribe and the adult educational system existing on the Fort Apache Indian Reservation.

The foregoing resolution was on May 12, 1988, duly adopted by a vote of TEN for and ZERO against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1(a) of the Amended Constitution and Bylaws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
