RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, Jarrett and Racheal (Lavender) Burnette; and Lonnie and Valerie (Cruz) Ethelbah; and Fernando and Jeanette (Cosen) Tenejieth have applied for tribal loans to construct new homes; and
- WHEREAS, a homesite lease is required by Section 21 (3) 2 of the Declaration of Policies and Plan of Operation approved July 22, 197 in order for these persons to construct homes; and
- WHEREAS, White Mountain Apache Tribe supports such loan acquisition and homesites provided the White Mountain Apache Tribe incurs no obligation on mortgaging the leasehold improvements to the White Mountain Apache Tribe Revolving Credit Program; and
- BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby approves and grants a homesite lease to Jarrett and Racheal (Lavender) Burnette; and Lonnie and Valerie (Cruz) Ethelbah; and Fernando and Jeanette (Cosen) Tenejieth for a period of twenty-five (25) years with an option for an additional term of twenty-five (25) years at a rate of \$1.00 for twenty-five 925) years, payable in advance on the first day of the month following the effective date of the lease.
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Tribal Chairman shall execute said leases for and on behalf of the White Mountain Apache tribe in accordance with Tribal Ordinance No. 44; the effective date of the commencement of said homesite leases being the date of the approval of the loan by the Secretary of the Interior or his designated representative.
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Tribal Chairman shall approve the leasehold mortgage mortgaging the improvements to the White Mountain Apache Tribe Revolving Credit Program.
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that should the loan not be approved within one hundred eighty (180) days from the date hereof, the lease and approval of right to mortgage the leasehold improvements shall thereby automatically terminate.

The foregoing resolution was on June 22, 1988, duly adopted by a vote of <u>SEVEN</u> for and <u>ZERO</u> against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and Bylaws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
