RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, it has come to the attention of the Tribal Council of the Fort Apache Indian Reservation that the McNary Elementary Public School is to be closed and elementary students will thereafter be bussed to other schools; and
- WHEREAS, a majority of students at the McNary School are members of the White Mountain Apache Tribe; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe believes it is in the interests of these elementary students to attend school near their homes.
- BE IT THEREFORE RESOLVED that the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe opposes the closure of the McNary Elementary School; and
- FURTHER BE IT RESOLVED that Councilman Ray Ivans is appointed to work on this issue for the Tribal Council.

The foregoing resolution was on June 22, 1988, duly adopted by a vote of NINE for and ZERO against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and Bylaws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
