

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe holds its regular monthly meetings, as well as special meetings, in the building generally referred to as the Tribal Council Chambers; and other meetings which benefit the White Mountain Apache Tribe are also held in said building; and

WHEREAS, no provision for a comfortable environment in which to meet during the hot summer months was built into the structure when it was constructed, and therefore the building becomes unreasonably hot, interfering with the use of the building;

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby approves the expenditure of tribal funds in the 88-89 fiscal year budget to provide air conditioning for the Tribal Council Chambers.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Tribal Controller is hereby directed to take the appropriate and necessary actions to accomplish this end.

The foregoing resolution was on June 22, 1988, duly adopted by a vote of EIGHT for and ONE against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and Bylaws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
