## RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, the Indian Health Service on the Fort Apache Indian Reservation is undertaking numerous projects involving the installation and/or improvement of domestic water supply and sewage disposal facilities; and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe believes it is in the best interests of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that these activities be reviewed before they are brought to the Tribal Council for specific action.

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that an ad hoc committee is hereby established to review IHS activities related to domestic water supply and sewage disposal facilities before Tribal Council action is needed on specific projects; and

FURTHER BE IT RESOLVED that Vice Chairman Alvino Hawkins shall serve on said committee as a member at large, Ronnie Lupe as a member from District I, Kino Kane as a member from District II, Matthew Nozie as a member from District III, and Nelson Ethelbah as a member from District IV.

The foregoing resolution was on June 22, 1988, duly adopted by a vote of <u>EIGHT</u> for and <u>ONE</u> against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and Bylaws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
