

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION


WHEREAS, on June 16, 1988 by Resolution No. 06-88-163, the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe took action to support Indian preference in employment in Arizona State and County agencies on or near Indian reservations; and

WHEREAS, the matter has been brought before the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe again.

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe hereby reaffirms its position as stated in Resolution No. 06-88-163 supporting Indian preference in employment in Arizona State and County agencies.

The foregoing resolution was on July 12, 1988, duly adopted by a vote of EIGHT for and ZERO against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1(i) of the Amended Constitution and Bylaws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
