RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, it has come to the attention of the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that tribal member Jackie Lee has been requesting a homesite from the Land board and the cattle association to no avail; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe believes it to be in the best interest of its' membership to have homesites made available.
- THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe hereby authorizes a homesite, 200' by 200' in the Hondah area behind the Smoke Shop for Jackie Lee, which homesite area is approximately depicted on the attached Exhibit "a" as Lot 80; and
- FURTHER BE IT RESOLVED that the Land Office further specifically identify said site by appropriate legal description.

The foregoing resolution was on August 3, 1988, duly adopted by a vote of <u>EIGHT</u> for and <u>ZERO</u> against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and Bylaws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
