FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION


WHEREAS, it has come to the attention of the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that Linda Kaye Lupe, Miss Indian America XXXII is sponsoring a Pow Wow at Fort Apache in August 26, 27, 28, 1988; and

WHEREAS, said Pow Wow will be a event with attendance from Indian tribal members nation wide and from Canada; and


WHEREAS, said Pow Wow will constitute a good public relations event for the White Mountain Apache Tribe thus it is in the best interest of the White Mountain Apache Tribe to support this event.

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe hereby directs that \$5,000 be donated to the Pow Wow event August 26, 27, 28, 1988 to be taken from the public relations account.

The foregoing resolution was on August 4, 1988, duly adopted by a vote of NINE for and ZERO against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and Bylaws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
