- WHEREAS, Mr. and Mrs. Russell Lupe have been chosen as Godparents and have accepted the role; and
- WHEREAS, arrangements are already underway for the necessary ceremonial activities to be held at the old tribal fairgrounds in Whiteriver.
- BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby grants the request of Mr. and Mrs. Ted Bourke, Sponsors, and Mr. and Mrs. Russell Lupe, Godparents to hold an Apache ceremonial Sunrise Dance for Annie Mary Bourke during the weekend of October 7, 8, 9, 1988 at the old tribal fairgrounds.

The foregoing resolution was on August 4, 1988, duly adopted by a vote of NINE for and ZERO against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (f), (g) & (k) of the Amended Constitution and Bylaws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
