## RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, the Housing Improvement Program Coordinator, Ms. Beverly Stago, has informed the Tribal Council that another home can be built under the Housing Improvement Program; and
- WHEREAS, Ms. Beverly Stago and the Selection Committee requested the Tribal Council advise them what district will get the home; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council has made a decision that the house be given to any district as long as it goes to a handicapped individual; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council desires that the Selection Committee do the selecting and that all normal procedures be followed;
- BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that the seventh home to be built under the Housing Improvement Program be given to a handicapped individual.

The foregoing resolution was on August 10, 1988, duly adopted by a vote of ELEVEN for and ZERO against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1(a),(j),(k) of the Amended Constitution and Bylaws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
