RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, Ms. Beverly Stago came before the Tribal Council requesting that she be able to use a Tribal vehicle to attend a New Directions Training Program in Sells, Arizona during the week of August 15-19, 1988; and
- WHEREAS, Ms. Beverly Stago explained to the Tribal Council that the training would benefit the Apache people on the White Mountain Apache Reservation who are dealing with alcoholism;
- BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe after discussion that approval for use of a tribal vehicle be given to Ms. Beverly Stago to attend the New Directions Training Program in Sells, Arizona during the week of August 15-19, 1988.

The foregoing resolution was on August 10, 1988, duly adopted by a vote of ELEVEN for and ZERO against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1(a),(j),(k) of the Amended Constitution and Bylaws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
