## RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, it has come to the attention of the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that a used culvert belonging to the Bureau of Indian Affairs Roads Department is apparently not in use by said agency; and
- WHEREAS, Councilman Matthew Nozie has requested that the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe support his request to the BIA Roads Department that the said agency declare the culvert surplus and donate the culvert to the White Mountain Apache Tribe for use by Councilman Nozie for community members who are in need.
- BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it supports Councilman Matthew Nozie's request and requests that the BIA donate the culvert to the White Mountain Apache tribe for community uses.

The foregoing resolution was on August 17, 1988, duly adopted by a vote of <u>SIX</u> for and <u>ZERO</u> against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and Bylaws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
