RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, Lucivia Colelay has brought to the attention of the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe a decision of the grievance committee dated May 31, 1988 upholding the decision of her supervisor, Gerald Alsenay, to terminate her from her position at Hon Dah; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe being fully advised on the premisses;
- THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that the recommendations of the Grievance Committee are upheld with the exception of language in #5 which indicates Ms. Colelay was terminated which termination is overturned; and
- FURTHER BE IT RESOLVED that Ms. Colelay is hereby suspended from her position at Hon Dah; and
- FURTHER BE IT RESOLVED that Gerald Alsenay is directed to carry out Grievance Committee's recommendation #6 as stated; and
- FURTHER BE IT RESOLVED that the investigation referred to in the Grievance Committee recommendations be undertaken immediately by BIA Law enforcement personnel who will report back to the Tribal Council within ten (10) days; and
- FURTHER BE IT RESOLVED that should a problem arise that the ten (10) day period cannot be met that the BIA Superintendent immediately notify the Tribal Chairman.

The foregoing resolution was on September 14, 1988, duly adopted by a vote of SIX for and ZERO against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and Bylaws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
