RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, the Director of Game and Fish of the White Mountain Apache Tribe has proposed to the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe 1988 Tribal Member Hunting Regulations; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe believes that it is in the best interests of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that hunting regulations be enacted to govern hunting by tribal members.
- THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe hereby enacts the 1988 Tribal Member Hunting Regulations as presented by the Director of Game and Fish of the White Mountain Apache Tribe.

The foregoing resolution was on September 14, 1988, duly adopted by a vote of SIX for and ZERO against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and Bylaws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
