

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, it has been brought to the attention of the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that a dispute over land use areas exists between Dorinda Alekay and Jack Fowler; and


WHEREAS, Jack Fowler is building a fence on an area that is claimed by Dorinda Alekay; and


WHEREAS, Raymus Albert is the Director of the Land Office for the White Mountain Apache Tribe and as such is responsible for land related matters;

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that Raymus Albert, the Director of the Land Office, is hereby directed to visit the site and investigate the land dispute between Dorinda Alekay and Jack Fowler, to gather all appropriate documents related to this matter, and to seek assistance from the Engineering Department if necessary for a survey, and to report back to the Tribal Council at the next regularly scheduled meeting;

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that Shirley Fowler, Jack Fowler and any of their representatives, are directed by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe to immediately cease and desist from any further fencing activities, such order to remain in effect until further action by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe.

The foregoing resolution was on November 10, 1988, duly adopted by a vote of TEN for and ZERO against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1(i) of the Amended Constitution and Bylaws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
