

RESOLUTION OF THE  
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE  
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, the July 30, 1988 incident and another more recent incident involving a White Mountain Apache Tribal police officer, Elaine Nez, has been brought to the attention of the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe by Roxanna Henry; and

WHEREAS, after much discussion the Tribal Council determines that said alleged internal police department personnel problems ought to be handled by the Chairman of the White Mountain Apache Tribe.


BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby directs the Chairman to investigate these allegations and report back to the Tribal Council;

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Chairman is authorized to take appropriate administration action.

The foregoing resolution was on November 10, 1988, duly adopted by a vote of EIGHT for and ONE against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1(i) of the Amended Constitution and Bylaws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
