RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe is advised that one of the turnouts on State Route 73 is unnecessary and indeed is unsafe; and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe is advised that Arizona Department of Transportation (ADOT) funds are available to eliminate such intersections;

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby directs the BIA to seek the necessary funds from ADOT needed to eliminate said turnout and upon receipt of said funding to carry out the task of eliminating the turnout on State Route 73, more particularly depicted on the map attached herein as Exhibit A.

The foregoing resolution was on November 10, 1988, duly adopted by a vote of ELEVEN for and ZERO against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1(i) of the Amended Constitution and Bylaws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
