WHEREAS, Mr. and Mrs. Henry Pope, grandparents of Tulsa Sue Pope, have requested Tribal Council approval to sponsor an Apache Ceremonial Sunrise Dance for their granddaughter during the weekend of June 16, 17, 18, 1989; and

WHEREAS, Mr. and Mrs. Richard Grimes have been chosen as Godparents and they have accepted the role; and


WHEREAS, arrangements are already underway for the necessary ceremonial activities to be held in Seven Mile.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby grants the request of Henry and Delores (Wright) Pope, Sponsors, and Richard and Marjorie (Williams) Grimes, Godparents to hold an Apache ceremonial Sunrise Dance for Tulsa Sue Pope during the weekend of June 16, 17, 18, 1989 at Seven Mile.

The foregoing resolution was on November 10, 1988, duly adopted by a vote of TEN for and ZERO against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1(f), (g) & (k) of the Amended Constitution and Bylaws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
