

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, Mr. and Mrs. Terry Cosay and relatives of Ronna Maria Tortice, have requested Tribal Council approval to sponsor an Apache Ceremonial Sunrise Dance for Ronna Maria Tortice during the weekend of June 30, July 1,2, 1989; and

WHEREAS, Ms. Minnie Toggie has been chosen as Godparent and she has accepted the role; and

WHEREAS, arrangements are already underway for the necessary ceremonial activities to be held at the old tribal fairgrounds in Whiteriver.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby grants the request of Mr. and Mrs. Terry Cosay, Sponsors, and Ms. Minnie Toggie, Godparent, to hold an Apache Ceremonial Sunrise Dance for Ronna Maria Tortice during the weekend of June 30, July 1, 2, 1989, at the old tribal fairgrounds.

The foregoing resolution was on November 10, 1988, duly adopted by a vote of TEN for and ZERO against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1(f),(g)&(k) of the Amended Constitution and Bylaws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
