BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby grants the request of Mr. and Mrs. George Button, Sponsors, and Mr. and Mrs. Preston Beach, Godparents, to hold an Apache Ceremonial Sunrise Dance for Harriett Hosetosavit during the weekend of May 19,20,21, 1989, in Cibecue.
