WHEREAS, Mrs. Bessie Quintero and Ms. Vanta (Quintero) Hinton have requested Tribal Council approval to sponsor an Apache Ceremonial Sunrise Dance for Carmen Hinton during the weekend of April 20-23, 1989; and

WHEREAS, Rosemary Dazen has been chosen as Godparent and she has accepted the role; and

WHEREAS, arrangements are already underway for the necessary ceremonial activities to be held at Canyon Day.


BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby grants the request of Mrs. Bessie Quintero and Vanta (Quintero) Hinton, Sponsors, and Rosemary Dazen, Godparent, to hold an Apache Ceremonial Sunrise Dance for Carmen Hinton during the weekend of April 20-23, 1989, at Canyon Day.

The foregoing resolution was on November 10, 1988, duly adopted by a vote of TEN for and ZERO against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1(f), (g) & (k) of the Amended Constitution and Bylaws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
