

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, tribal members Jacqueline Henry, DOB: 02-13-71, and Patricia Henry, DOB: 10-12-72, daughters of tribal member Patrick Henry, Jr., have through their guardian formally requested that their tribal membership with the White Mountain Apache Tribe be relinquished so that they may remain on the official Tribal Roll of the Tribe of their mother, Louella (Kraiser) Lupe, which is the Pyramid Lake Tribe of Nixon, Nevada; and

WHEREAS, said relinquishment will be irrevocable since the Tribal Council has received a letter from Pyramid Lake attesting to the current enrollment of Patricia and Jacqueline Henry at Pyramid Lake, and these individuals have expressed an intention to maintain their residence and tribal affiliation at Pyramid Lake; and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Enrollment Committee has reviewed the relinquishment requests and recommends to the Tribal Council that it approve the voluntary disenrollment of Jacqueline and Patricia Henry from the Tribal Rolls of the White Mountain Apache Tribe.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby grants the request of Patricia and Jacqueline Henry who have voluntarily relinquished their enrollment with the White Mountain Apache Tribe. The Enrollment Committee and the Tribal Council Secretary are directed to take all necessary actions to carry out the intent and purposes of this resolution.

The foregoing resolution was on November 10, 1988, duly adopted by a vote of TEN for and ZERO against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article III, Section 3 of the Amended Constitution and Bylaws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
