

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, Tribal Treasurer, Lloyd W. Susan, has come before the Tribal Council and requested assistance on behalf of the Whiteriver Infant Stimulation and Preschool Program vehicle repair and maintenance; and

WHEREAS, Tribal Treasurer, Lloyd W. Susan, requests that interest accrued from the allocated unused Revenue Sharing Funds be appropriated for this purpose in the amount of \$1,525.00; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Federal Regulations pertaining to Revenue Sharing Funds, public meetings must be held and this meeting can be considered as the first public meeting and that hereafter two (2) more public meetings must be scheduled before Revenue Sharing Funds can be finally appropriated for the program.


BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby approves the appropriation of interest from Federal Revenue Sharing Funds in the amount of \$1,525.00 for the purpose of assisting the Whiteriver Infant Stimulation and Preschool Program.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council that in accordance with Federal Regulations this meeting shall constitute the first public meeting of three (3) meetings necessary prior to the actual appropriation of the Revenue Sharing Funds described herein and directs Mr. Susan to schedule two more public meetings in the near future in order to satisfy the requirements of the Federal Revenue Sharing Fund Program.

The foregoing resolution was on November 10, 1988, duly adopted by a vote of NINE for and ZERO against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1(i) of the Amended Constitution and Bylaws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
