

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, Mr. Reagan Armstrong, Sr.'s term as a Tribal Council member of the White Mountain Apache Tribe has expired; and
- WHEREAS, it is in the best interest of the White Mountain Apache Tribe to have a Tribal Council Member serve on the Sherman Indian School Board; and
- WHEREAS, the White Mountain Apache Tribal Council feels that Council Member Herbert Tate meets the requirements of Board membership and can adequately represent the interests of the White Mountain Apache Tribe;
- THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache that it hereby appoints Herbert Tate to serve on the Sherman Indian School Board.

The foregoing resolution was on November 10, 1988, duly adopted by a vote of EIGHT for and ZERO against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1(a) of the Amended Constitution and Bylaws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
