## RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, Joseph Ivins, the oldest living White Mountain Apache tribal member, may not be able to participate in the Elderly Program's planned trip to Disneyland unless he can make the trip by air; and
- WHEREAS, if arrangements can be made for air travel it is expected that Joseph Ivins will personally meet Mickey Mouse at Disneyland and make a presentation to Mr. Mouse on behalf of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, it being appropriate for Mr. Ivins to make such presentation as the oldest living tribal member to Mr. Mouse who is also an elderly person; and
- WHEREAS, such arrangements are in the best interests of the White Mountain Apache Tribe.
- BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby directs that roundtrip air fare to California for Joseph Ivins be paid for from Councilman Ray Ivans account so Joseph Ivins can participate in the planned Disneyland activities.

The foregoing resolution was on November 10, 1988, duly adopted by a vote of TEN for and ZERO against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1(h),(i) of the Amended Constitution and Bylaws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
