RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, there now exists on the Navajo County School Board a vacancy which term expires in two years; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe desires to make recommendations for the appointment to said vacancy; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe believes that Monte Stover should be recommended as the person to be considered to fill said vacancy; Adam Lupe and Matthew Nozie are to be considered as alternates;
- BE IT RESOLVED that the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe hereby recommends to the Board of County Supervisors that Monte Stover is recommended for consideration to fill the vacancy on the Navajo County School Board, and that Adam Lupe and Matthew Nozie be considered as alternates.

FURTHER BE IT RESOLVED that Bill Bennett, the Navajo County School Superintendent, be so advised.

The foregoing resolution was on November 22, 1988, duly adopted by a vote of <u>SEVEN</u> for and <u>ZERO</u> against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1(i) of the Amended Constitution and Bylaws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
