RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council has been informed that the Carrizo Community Building is not functional and should be closed; and
- WHEREAS, since there will be no activity in the Community Building, Mr. Walker Truax has requested from the Tribal Council approval to sponsor a one week church related fund raising activity beginning February 20 through February 25, 1989;
- BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that Mr. Walker Truax is granted his request to hold church related activities during the week of February 20 through 25, 1989.
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that any future activities to be sponsored will be proposed to the Community Officers for consideration.

The foregoing resolution was on February 8, 1989, duly adopted by a vote of EIGHT for and ZERO against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section (i) of the Amended Constitution and Bylaws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
