FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION


WHEREAS, the Tribal Council has been presented with a report of expenses incurred for the 1988 Christmas parties for communities throughout the reservation; and

WHEREAS, the Christmas parties and/or distribution of candy were given to spread good cheer and to uplift the spirit of the unfortunate and is in the best interest of the White Mountain Apache Tribe and its' members.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that the total amount of \$6,886.42 is hereby authorized for payment from the General Recreation Funds of Land Claims Monies for the 1988 Community Christmas activities.

The foregoing resolution was on February 8, 1989, duly adopted by a vote of EIGHT for and ZERO against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section (i) of the Amended Constitution and Bylaws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
